To revise some work on maps you did in Year 4 and what we would have done in Year 5 we'd like you to have a go at creating a piece of art like this:

A few suggestions for how you could do this differently:

- Print off a map using Google Maps.
- Use a map of the area around your house so you can go out and see the things you want to sketch.
- Use a map of an area you visited in the past and then use Google Street View to see the landmarks from a different perspective.
- Instead of painting parts of the map white you could stick white paper over the landmarks you want to draw.
- If you don't feel confident about using scissors at the end, draw the landmarks on paper before then cut round the outline and stick them on the map.
