Did you know: The largest game of musical chairs began with 8,238 participants at the Anglo-Chinese School in Singapore. Three and a half hours later, the game ended.


Did you know: The largest game of musical bumps consists of 1,276 people, and was achieved by Altrincham Grammar School for Girls (UK).


