Roadmap stage 3

As we move to stage 3 of the Covid recovery roadmap, the government has issued new Operational guidance for Schools.

Having been through it carefully, I'm afraid that very little changes for us at Primary school level. We must still wear masks when social distancing cannot be enforced; we must still limit numbers in bubbles in school and on the site and we're still not allowed to have assemblies and sing together. Obviously, the big news that face masks don't have to be worn in classrooms doesn't affect us.

Taking all this into consideration, we have decided that there are no changes to be made to our current systems all of which are outlined in the Parents' handbook March 2021 on the website.

We are very grateful to all of you for your support during this time; after all, all of this relies on everyone following the rules- and we know that some of them are irksome. We hope that we will be able to make changes when/if stage 4 comes into effect, but this will obviously depend on the guidance at that time.

In the meantime, please remember to follow the one-way system; wear a mask on the school site and only have one adult collecting.

Autism Parent Carer programme Preschool/Early Years/Year 1

Teachers and therapists will deliver virtual sessions via ZOOM.

It will include modules designed to increase your knowledge and skills with understanding and practical strategies to implement at home. The programme also allows parents to share their ideas and knowledge with other parents and professionals. The modules have been designed based on feedback from parents (collated over the past few years), updates in current research and good practice.

To access this programme, you must meet the following criteria:

- Child has a diagnosis of Autism
- Child is not yet in nursery/ in nursery/in Reception/in year 1.
- Barnet resident (If your child is year 2 or above, you can access the Cygnets Programme Cygnets- Autism Advisory team)
