

### **Summer Party**

Thank you to everybody who has bought tickets for the Summer Party. Ticket sales have been amazing and this weekend will be your last opportunity to buy tickets if you want to come. **NO MORE TICKETS** will be sold next week and tickets **CANNOT** be purchased at the door so please do not turn up if you have not purchased a ticket via Parentmail as we do not want to disappoint anybody (especially your children)!

Please note that **EVERY** person attending must have bought a ticket on Parentmail even if you are volunteering!

Children must be accompanied by an adult or they will be denied entry and it is your responsibility to supervise your children for the whole duration of the event.

Unfortunately, Covid has not gone away and we do not want to spoil anybody's plans for the summer holidays so we do need you to adhere to the following:

- It would be great if all secondary school children and grown ups could take a lateral flow test before they come to the party



- Whilst at the party, please ensure you are regularly sanitising your hands
- Face masks must be worn by grown ups when ordering from the BBQ and bars.
- If any members of the family have any one symptom of Covid, please do not come to the party until you have received a negative PCR test. Symptoms are:
  - a high temperature, or
  - a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual), or
  - a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If you are coming to the party, please contact your Class Rep to help. We have over 250 grown ups coming to the party so between us, we are sure jobs can be shared so that we can all relax and enjoy the party especially as we do not have any many stalls to run as we usually do.

We will be setting up from 12pm and will need some muscle to move things about and set up gazebos. This should only take an hour or two if we get enough helpers.
