Congratulations to everyone who has made it through to nearly the end of September! Our attendance rate is 96% at the moment which, given the number of colds around, is very good!

The end of September does mean that the weather has changed, but we still need to make sure that our rooms are well ventilated and that the children are outside as much as possible. This means that it's really important that the children have their jumpers and coats with them everyday; they don't have to wear them all the time but they might need them! Please make sure that all uniform is named and encourage them to take it home at night. I know that our beginning and end of day routines are a little different this term, but they are becoming more familiar now and encouraging the children to take responsibility for their own equipment (lunch bags, clothes, bottles) is very good for them!

A reminder to parents who have children in KS1 and KS2; in the morning we ask that you walk around the outside of the school to drop off at the two gates. In the evening you may cross from the KS2 playground to the KS1 playground but not the other way. As before, we ask that only one person collects and that you wear a mask if you are able to. Children should stay with their parents when collected and not be allowed to play on either playground.

We're delighted to say that the kitchen is up and running again and that (after a slight delay!) the menu choices are on the website. Please make sure you order in advance. This is especially important for FS and KS1; universal Infant Free school meals means you don't have to pay for these but you do need to make a daily choice for your child.

Reminder – the Office staff are unable to take in anything your child may have forgotten to bring to school including water bottles, packed lunch, book bags etc... If they do not have a lunch a school one will be provided but you will need to make payment via the Feeding Hungry Minds website.

Free School Meals

Please remember to let us know if you think you are eligible for free school meals especially if your child has moved into KS2 (Y3-Y6) and is no longer entitled to universal free school meals. The eligibility criteria is on our website https://www.sacredheartprimary.co.uk/1331/free-school-meals-1 Please apply even if you are in FS/KS1 at the moment as things like the FSM vouchers which ran through the lockdown are triggered by this.

Please do not send your child to school if they have any of the following symptoms:

A high temperature – this means they feel hot to touch on their chest or back

- A new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if they usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss of, or change in, their normal sense of smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

It is also important that you **do not send your child to school** if somebody in your household has tested positive for, or has symptoms of, coronavirus.

As a precaution, your child must not come into school for **14 days** after coronavirus has been identified in your household, whether confirmed or unconfirmed.

Please notify the <u>school office</u> via <u>telephone and email</u> as soon as possible if your child, or somebody in your household, is showing symptoms of coronavirus and your child cannot come into school
