## DECLARATION OF ELIGIBILITY

***Being a school governor is a highly valued role within the education system. Being a governor, although voluntary, is a position of importance and trust. Because of this, there are restrictions on who can be a governor. The restrictions are as follows:***

*A person cannot be a parent governor if he or she:*

- Is under the age of 18 years at the date of his or her appointment
- Is already a governor at the same school
- Is paid to work at the school for more than 500 hours per year
- Is liable to be detained under the Mental Health Act 1983
- Has been adjudged bankrupt and the bankruptcy order has not been annulled or rescinded
- Has been subject to a disqualification order under the Company Directors Disqualifications Act 1986 or to an order made under the Insolvency Act for failure to pay under a county court administration order
- Has been removed from the office of charity trustee for a charity
- Is included in the list of teachers and workers with young children or young persons whose employment is prohibited or restricted (List 99)
- Has been disqualified for being the proprietor of any independent school or for being a teacher or other employee in any school
- Has been convicted of a criminal offence (for full details see the Regulations)

*In cases where no parent of a pupil at the school is willing to stand for election as parent governor, the governing body may appoint a parent of a child who attends another school. In such cases, a person cannot be appointed as a parent governor if he or she:*

- Is an elected member of the local education authority
