LI: To edit and improve



Top Tip

If you haven't finished writing your narrative from yesterday – now is a good time to finish this, and you can spend some time editing tomorrow....(shhh.....I won't be setting any English for you to complete tomorrow, so you have a bit of time!)

If you have finished then you will now be editing and improving your writing.

Editing

The best way to approach your editing of the narrative is to think carefully about how clear you have made your description.

- Have you missed any opportunity to clarify a particular description to the reader?
- Are your language choices appropriate for the mood?
- Have you described in detail the characters and setting?
- Is there an opportunity for you to show off any grammatical techniques that are appropriate?

Remember also to check for non-negotiable things like spellings, full stops and capital letters.

When you have done this, read your work to a family member and see if you notice any areas that you could further improve.
