

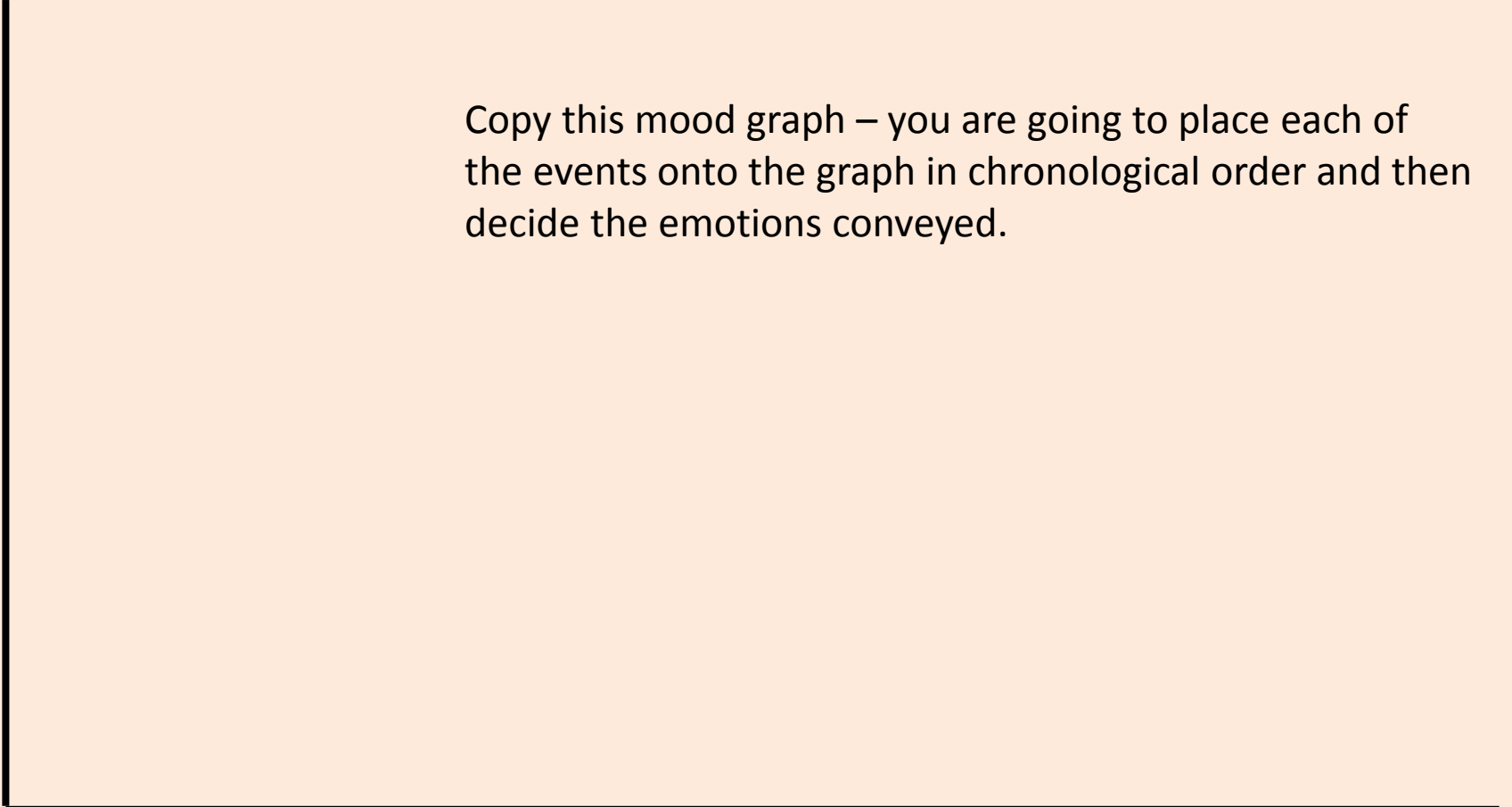

mood graph

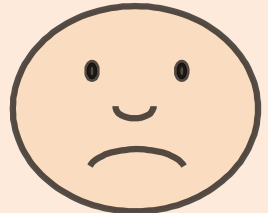


Copy this mood graph – you are going to place each of the events onto the graph in chronological order and then decide the emotions conveyed.

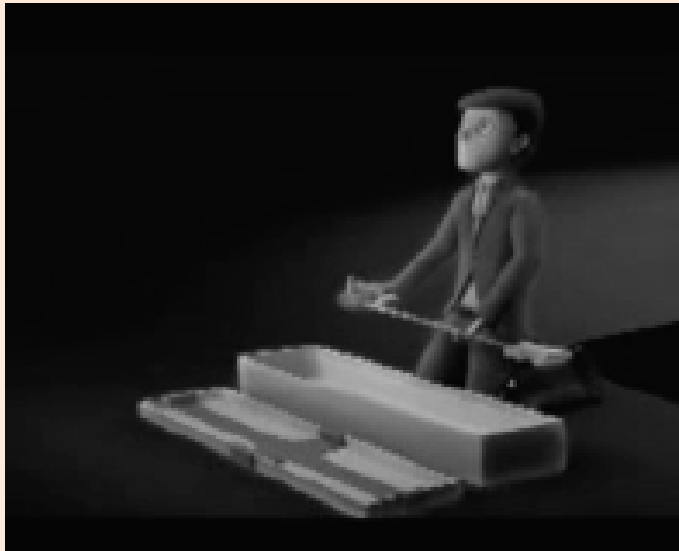
