LI: To explain belief in the Kingdom of
God expressed in the parables

Recap: What is meant by the Kingdom of God?

- Matthew talks about the Kingdom of Heaven through a series of parables
- He refers to it as the Kingdom of Heaven as he was Jewish. However, we also refer to it as the Kingdom of God
- The Kingdom of God is like a mustard seed that will start small and grow into something monumental
- Some people are more willing than others to hear the word of God, and that is represented by the types of soil in the parable of the sower.
- In God's kingdom, we must be able to respond to God's word and therefore grow (just like the seed did in the good soil).

Our beliefs about the kingdom

Our beliefs can affect the way we behave. Have a look at the table below. Can you think of any more beliefs in God's kingdom and how they affect your behaviour?

BELIEF	BEHAVIOUR
Honesty is important	Tell the truth
Everyone should have access to food and clean water	Give to charity
It is important to help in your community	Find out how to volunteer and help others
Education is important	Become a teacher
Only God's recognition is important	Don't show off for the recognition of friends or teachers
